

TEEN SUPPORT PROGRAM

The Teen Support Program is an extension of the PLC Health Clinic's regular services of providing abstinence education to teen girls. If a teen is unable to come to the agency for these services, the Teen Support Program makes a PLC Health Clinic worker available to meet with a teen at her home school during free period, study hall, lunch, or after school. The PLC Health Clinic worker will provide education on abstinence as a way of life, risks of pregnancy and STDs, self worth, setting boundaries, making wise choices, choosing good role models, and secondary virginity. Incentives will be offered for attendance and completion of the course. Involvement in this program is voluntary and offered as a service to provide support to teens.
