

MORE THAN JUST NUMBERS...

Trina Langdon was the Executive Director of the PLC for 14 years. Watching God work through her to build our ministry was amazing. Our fundraising soared to new heights as a result of Trina's new ideas, allowing us to serve countless additional patients. Our Walk for Life went from raising \$25,000 to \$71,000 (individual walkers and business/church partners combined) annually because of the faithful generosity of the members of this community. Trina also had the vision for the medical clinic and made it happen! Consider for a moment the magnitude of that undertaking! There were countless hours of research, navigating legalities and insurance, finding and training staff, and writing policies and procedures, all while promoting it within the community in order to gain funding. Current annual fundraising for the clinic is \$75,000 (individuals and business underwriters).

In 2011 and 2014, **Trina created our PI.N.K. and B.L.U.E. teen programs**, which took our message of purity and self-worth in Christ into the local schools. Sometimes on the surface, things seem to have just fallen together. But when we stop for a moment and think about all that actually had to go into it-the hours of phone calls, the research, the training, the fundraising-we see that it really wasn't as simple as it first appeared. No matter what, though, when we later look back at the fruits of our labor, its easy to see the impact, and this makes it all worth it! So let's take a quick look at some of the PLC's results under Trina's leadership, remembering that **each number is actually a beautiful soul, created and cherished by God.**

From January 2016 until now, there have been a total of **992 new patients** at the PLC. That would just about fill a high school gymnasium to capacity. **244 precious babies**, created in God's very own image have been born. Imagine a packed movie theater, and that is about the number of babies born during Trina's service at the PLC. The school programs she created back in 2011/2014 have had the privilege of walking alongside **670 teens**.

The clinic has only been active since 2017, and in that time there have been **276 ultrasounds** in which mothers caught a glimpse of the beauty growing in their wombs. The PLC Health Clinic has cared for **117 abortion vulnerable patients**, loving them through one of the most challenging and pivotal moments of their lives. The average graduating class size in our area is close to **117**; Imagine an entire graduating class simply not existing and you'll understand the magnitude of that number. We have tested **164 STI patients**, educating each on the impacts of their choices both now and in their futures. Each one of our patients is presented with the gospel by our staff.

Numbers don't lie. And **these numbers are a strong testament of the impact Trina Langdon has made** not only in our facility, but in our community. We will never be able to express our love and gratitude to her, and we know there are many out there whose lives have been positively impacted by her, either as a patient or as a supporter, who feel the same way. **Trina, you will be greatly missed**. We value and appreciate you, not only for your hard work in realizing your visions for the PLC over the years, but for simply being you. **The staff, supporters, and patients of the PLC pray God's blessings over you in this new chapter of your life.**
