Part of our mission at the PLCHC is to educate the community and we are so blessed when others choose to walk along side us to do just that. We were so humbled when Peony Queen Jill Gemmer reached out to us stating that she had chosen to donate to the PLC Health Clinic as her first opportunity to sow back into the Van Wert community. With Jill's permission, we wanted to share the personal and touching story that she shared at the Peony Pageant...the "why" behind choosing our organization. Jill states, "DID YOU KNOW: in 2015 there were 20,976 abortions performed in Ohio? The population of Van Wert in 2017 was 10,654. With that being said, the amount of abortions in Ohio that year alone would have wiped out the population of Van Wert twice. Almost 20 years ago, a fifteen year old girl was in a nonconsensual sexual encounter and was raped. That girl who was raped gave birth to me. If I would have been aborted, I would not have the chance to be standing here today, devoting time to community organizations and providing to those around me. No one knows the potential of a child if he or she doesn't have a chance from the moment of conception. Last year when I was interviewing for Queen Jubilee XLV, I vividly remember being asked what a major goal in life is and I answered, 'Being philanthropic and making an impact on my community.' I remember stating that it can be hard for younger people to have the financial stability to give back monetary wise and it has always been a dream of mine. This past year being crowned the Peony Queen has given me the chance today to be able to donate \$500 to the Pregnancy Life Center and making my first donation back to our community."

Thank you, Jill, for sharing your beautiful testimony and for the amazing heart you have in being someone who chooses to "be a voice for the voiceless."
