board-certified by the American Board of Obstetricians and Gynecologists, is a Fellow of the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists, serves as Medical Director of Clinical Research at The Jackson Clinic, and has served as the Principal Investigator for scores of clinical trials. During his career he has delivered over 4,000 babies. Before becoming a strong proponent of the Pro-Life movement, Dr. Hammond performed more than 700 abortions as a resident at The Medical College of Georgia. Today he passionately speaks for the Pro-Life movement on the Sanctity of Life.



Christmas came early to the PLC as we recently purchased a *new ultrasound machine*! While this was needed to keep our clinic running smoothly, it was a rather large expense. Perhaps you might consider an end-of-year donation to help offset this unexpected cost. We were thankful for Hobie Sears of Probo Medical as he was instrumental in helping us secure the most cost-effective machine for our facility. It was a comfort to know that he works with multiple other pregnancy centers (PRCs), and that he and his wife have a heart for prolife agencies. Hobie writes the following:

"I have been working with PRCs and their ultrasound systems for nearly 15 years. I help with troubleshooting ultrasound issues and also help navigate the purchase of equipment. My focus is to be as cost-conscious as possible while still delivering quality service. Communication is a vital and constant process as I work to be sure they understand the market and assist them in saving some money along the way.

An ultrasound machine will be perhaps the largest purchase a PRC will make. After multiple conversations with PLC clinic staff to discuss their specific needs, I had a solid understanding and was able to recommend a system that fit them very well and will service them into the future nicely.

My involvement in the PRC community has increased since my wife, Cami, a sonographer, took a job with Women's Centers of Ohio as the Ultrasound Medical Manager for all of their locations. During this time, I've become more involved with the national support groups for PRCs. I've spoken at several conferences at Heartbeat and the company I work for has provided facilities and equipment for NIFLA to perform training.

We both enjoy working in the PRC community and helping them realize and understand the advantage of a quality ultrasound machine and how it helps with their mission."
