Updates

Executive Director Jody Wannemacher recently attended the annual pregnancy help conference with Heartbeat International in April. Heartbeat's Annual Conference is designed for ministry leaders, staff, board members, and volunteers of life-affirming pregnancy help centers, medical clinics, maternity homes, and non-profit adoption agencies, as well as professionals in the areas of medicine, counseling, social work, and education.

Throughout the week, the PLC's focused track was housing; establishing, managing and growing a maternity home. These sessions discussed the importance of trauma-informed care, what it looks like to work with those who have deep past trauma, and the growing need for maternity homes across the country. Other topics covered were adding daycares to maternity homes to empower employment for residents, addiction and recovery within housing and taking residents from maternity housing to transitional living. This training gave us a great deal of useful information to help us continue to work our way through the final stages of planning for The Langdyn House.

The 1-1 training that has been taking place with Suzanne Burns at BeCharityWise out of Cleveland, Tennessee is beginning to wrap up.
